

- Excavators are required to request the location of underground facilities at each excavation site by notifying the one call centre and/or facility owner.
- Contact the Alberta One-Call Centre at least two business days before starting your project.
- When necessary, the excavator or the locator may request a pre-excavating meeting at the jobsite just prior to the actual marking of facility locations.
- Not all buried facilities are registered with AOC. It is the ground disturber's responsibility to determine if non-member facility operators have buried facilities in the area and to notify them directly.
- When working on privately owned land (farms, universities, military bases, etc.) privately owned facilities may be present. These have been designed and installed by the landowner for their benefit and will typically need to have a separate third-party sweep/locate completed to identify any buried facilities.
- Be aware that privately owned buried facilities (e.g. pool and barbeque lines) may exist within the work area.
